NOTICE OF RACE

- **Rules**
 - The series will be governed by the rules as defined in The International Sailing Federation (ISAF) Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012.
 - The Prescriptions and Special Regulations Part 2 (Off the Beach Boats) will apply.
 - The rules of the Australian IODA.

- **Eligibility**
 - All competitors shall be current financial members of NSW IODA.

- **Entry & Qualification**
 - The series is open to all NSWIODA members that compete in at least three Travellers Trophy events are automatically entered.

- **Travellers Trophy Series Events**

- **Racing**
 - Racing will be held according to the sailing instructions of the host club.
- **Measurement**
 - All boats and equipment shall comply with current class measurement rules and restrictions.
 - NSWIODA and the Organising Authority of each event reserve the right to inspect any boat, its measurement certificate if applicable and equipment at any time during the regatta.
 - Boats and equipment may be inspected at any time to ensure compliance with Yachting Australia Special Regulation, Part 2 "Off the beach boats", R1, Personal Buoyancy.
- **Sailing Instructions**
 - The sailing instructions for each event will be available according to the notice of race for the event.
- **Sailing Areas**

The race areas will be: Lake Illawarra, Lake Burley Griffin, Upper Sydney Harbour and Hunters Bay, Sydney.

- **Scoring**
 - Results from all Travellers Trophy events will count.
 - A boat's score in the Travellers Trophy Series will be the sum of their overall finishing positions at their best three events.
 - The boat with the lowest aggregate score will be the winner
- **Wind Speed Limit**

These will be established in the sailing instruction for each event.

- **Prizes**
 - Prizes will be awarded by NSW IODA for the first three placed boats in the series.
 - The presentation will take place at MHYC immediately after the completion of the last event of the series.

- **Disclaimer**

It is the competitor's decision to enter an Event or to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in an Event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organising Authority and the Host Club, their officers, members, servants and agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in an Event or how so ever arising in connection with an Event.

It is a condition of entry that each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 million.
